51 Village Voice

a. Current financial position

The Clerk handed round the Current Financial Position. There was £5930.00 from the previous year and £3544.50 from this year so far which gives a total income of £9474.50. The total expenditure so far is £1896.31, which gives a balance of £7578.19.
